Every team is different, so expect managers will customize tools to fit their needs and the culture.

**Backgrounder** – Give managers the nuts and bolts with resources such as:

- A brief timeline of events
- Data or diagrams that explain key points

**Checklist** – Give them a clear, easy plan to avoid roadblocks and include:

- All action items
- Schedules for communications and team meetings
- Strategies for mitigating concerns

**Conversation Starters** – Provide questions to jumpstart team conversations such as:

• "What are the pros and cons?"

- "How could this change benefit your day-to-day work?"
- "What support would be helpful?"

**Agendas** – Help steer conversations by providing suggested meeting agendas that include:

- Scripted beginning and ending messages
- Answers to FAQs managers may face

**PowerPoint Template** – Make it easy for managers to deliver key messages with pre-populated slides addressing:

- Why the change is important, how teams will be impacted and next steps
- Visuals that help tell the data story
- Quotes from leaders

**Recognition Tools** – Let managers know how their team can participate in celebration opportunities such as:

- 'Champions of change' awards, branded to fit your initiative
- Spotlight stories for the company's newsletters and intranet

## Could this journey use a dose of **fun**? Consider:

- Creating a card game featuring ethical scenarios for a code-of-conduct launch
- Compiling a themed music playlist to energize meetings about the new company mission
- Creating a digital recognition wall for employees who demonstrate the company's values
- Developing a set of mystery questions to kick off team meetings
- Gamifying the learning with Bingo- or Jeopardy-inspired activity templates
- Creating a digital scavenger hunt to explore a new online tool or resource
